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Pursuant to stipulation,

1. In this action, which was filed on or about September 17, 2003, Veeco alleged infringement of United States Patent Nos. 5,224,376; 5,237,859; Re. 36,488; 5,266,801 and 5,415,027; violation of the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act; violation of the Computer Data Access and Fraud Act; trespass to chattels and replevin. Asylum counterclaimed against Veeco for infringement of United States Patent No. 5,825,020 and breach of contract. This Court has jurisdiction over this action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331, 1338(a), 1367(a).

2. In light of the risks and expenses of further litigation of this action, Veeco and Asylum have reached a settlement of their dispute as set forth in this Stipulated Judgment and Order and the License Agreement concurrently executed by the parties ("Agreement").

3. This action, including all claims, defenses, affirmative defenses and counterclaims, shall be dismissed with prejudice except insofar as this Court shall retain exclusive, continuing jurisdiction to enforce, administer, and/or interpret this Stipulated Judgment and Order, and the Agreement.

4. Veeco and Asylum shall each bear their own legal costs and attorneys' fees incurred in this action.
